SKATECANADA

CANSKATE

CANSKATE is a learn-to-skate program for beginners of all ages that focuses on fun, participation and basic skill development to prepare skaters for any ice skating sport or recreational skating.

PreCanSkate and CanSkate Program Highlights:

- Experienced Skate Canada certified coaches
- Program assistants helping on the ice.

PreCanSkate

The program is designed for children with no skating ability. Participants must be 3 years old.

Session Times:

Monday: 5:45 - 6:15pm

Friday: 5:30 - 6pm or 6 - 6:30pm

NEW THIS YEAR: 12 & 24 week sessions

1 day/week (Monday or Friday)

\$120 for 12 weeks (start Sept. 14 or Jan. 7)

\$185 for 24 weeks (Sept. 14 – Mar. 31)

2 days/week (Monday and Friday)

\$170 for 12 weeks (start Sept. 14 or Jan. 7)

\$280 for 24 weeks (Sept. 14 – Mar. 31)

FAMILY DISCOUNT

Families with three or more skaters receive a discount of 50% off the third or lowest session fee, whichever is less.

FUNDRAISING

ALL PHFSC programs have a mandatory fundraising fee of \$100/family that is not included in the base price. Payable at registration.



HELMETS

All skaters are required to wear a regulation CSA approved and properly fastened hockey helmet (no bicycle helmets) that covers the entire head during skating sessions. Helmets must be worn **until your child has passed Badge 5 (as per Skate Canada)**

PARENT ATTENDANCE

All skaters under the age of 12 **MUST** have a parent or guardian in attendance at the arena during his/her skating session.

CanSkate

This program is designed for children who have passed the PreCanSkate Badge or for children with some skating ability.

Session Times:

Monday 5:30-6:20pm

Friday 5:40-6:30pm

1 day/week (Monday or Friday)

\$150 for 12 weeks (start Sept. 14 or Jan. 7)

\$210 for 24 weeks (Sept. 14 – Mar. 31)

2 days/week (Monday and Friday)

\$200 for 12 weeks (start Sept. 14 or Jan. 7)

\$330 for 24 weeks (Sept. 14 – Mar. 31)
